AMEND THE **LEATHER, CANVAS AND SHEET PLASTIC FABRICATION AWARD** IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

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Delete Clause 13 - Holidays with Pay, subclause (a) and insert in lieu thereof the following:

(a) All employees (other than casuals) shall be allowed the following days as paid:

New Year's Day, Australia Day, Hobart Regatta Day (South of Oatlands), Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined), Recreation Day (where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed), Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

OPERATIVE DATE:

The operative date for the foregoing amendment is 3 October 1991.

Delete Clause 27 - Superannuation, subclause (d) (i) and insert in lieu thereof the following:

(d) Employer Contributions

(i) Subject to the rules of the Fund, and paragraph (iii) herein, an employer shall contribute to the Fund in respect of each employee who is a member of the Fund an amount at the rate of three per cent of ordinary time earnings for each complete week employed. This calculation shall be based on the ordinary time worked by an employee in any week and shall exclude work performed and paid as overtime.

Contributions to the fund shall be made by the employer on at least a calendar monthly basis unless there are circumstances for which the employer cannot be held responsible.

OPERATIVE DATE:

The operative date for the foregoing amendment is the first full pay period commencing on or after 1 October 1991.
