THE ABOVE AWARD IS VARIED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

1. Delete Clause 6 - Parties and Persons Bound, and insert in lieu thereof the following.

"6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;

- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) the Federation of Industrial Manufacturing and Engineering Employees, Tasmania Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope; and
 - (iii) the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iv) the Textile, Clothing and Footwear Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (d) the following organisations of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Retail Traders Association of Tasmania, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries."
