BUSINESS SERVICES AWARD

CORRECTION ORDER

THE COMMISSION, pursuant to Section 19(2)(a) of the *Act*, hereby corrects Order No. 1 of 2001 (Consolidated) (T8681 of 1999), and Order No. 1 of 2002 (Consolidated) (T10230 of 2002, T10288 of 2002 and T10289 of 2002) for the making of the current award by deleting from Part V – Hours of Work, Penalty Payments and Overtime, Clause 7 – Shift Work, subclause (j) – Sundays and Holidays with Pay and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(j) Sundays and Holidays with Pay

Shift workers on continuous shifts for work carried out on a rostered shift the major portion of which is performed on a Sunday or holiday with pay as prescribed in Part VI - Leave and Holidays, Clause 4 - Holidays with Pay shall be paid at the rate of time and a half.

Shift workers on other than continuous work for all time worked on a Sunday or holiday with pay as prescribed in Part VI - Leave and Holidays, Clause 4 - Holidays with Pay shall be paid at the rates prescribed in Part V - Hours of Work, Penalty Payments and Overtime, Clause 6 – Sunday Work or Part VI – Leave and Holidays, Clause 4(c) – Holidays with Pay. Where shifts commence between 11.00 pm and midnight on a Sunday or holiday with pay as prescribed in Part VI - Leave and Holidays, Clause 4 - Holidays with Pay, the time so worked before midnight shall not entitle the employee to the Sunday or holiday rate as prescribed in Part V - Hours of Work, Penalty Payments and Overtime, Clause 6 – Sunday Work or Part VI – Leave and Holidays, Clause 4(c) – Holidays with Pay.

PROVIDED that the time worked by an employee on a shift commencing before midnight on the day preceding a Sunday or holiday with pay as prescribed in Part VI - Leave and Holidays, Clause 4 - Holidays with Pay and extending into a Sunday or holiday with pay shall be regarded as time worked on such Sunday or holiday with pay."
