CORRECTION ORDER

WHEREAS an error occurred in the order dated 1 September 1993 (T.4538 of 1993) varying the Restaurant Keepers Award, in accordance with Section 21(1) of the Act the Commission hereby corrects Order No.1 of 1993 in the following manner:

Delete from Clause 8 – Wage Rates, subclause 5 – Trainees, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"5. TRAINEES

The minimum weekly wage rate payable to trainees (ATS) (as defined) shall be determined by the following methods of calculation:

- (a) Trainee Clerk - by taking the appropriate wage rate for a junior clerk as prescribed in subclause 3 of this clause and multiplying it by 39 and then dividing it by 52.
- (b) Hospitality Trainee and Food Preparation and Service Trainee - by taking the appropriate junior percentage as prescribed in subclause 3 of this clause, applying it to the total wage rate prescribed for Food & Beverage Service Grade 2 in subclause 1 of this clause and multiplying the result by 39 and then dividing it by 52.

PROVIDED that the wage determined by these calculations shall in no case be less than the minimum rate (as varied from time to time) prescribed by the Australian Traineeship Guidelines.

In the above formulae, 39 represents the actual number of weeks out of the total 52 weeks of the traineeship that is spent on the job.
