"6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (b) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award and who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) the National Union of Workers, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iii) The Salaried Pharmacists' Association (Tasmania Branch) and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iv) the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (v) the Transport Workers' Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (d) the following organisations of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) The Pharmacy Guild of Australia, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) The Retail Traders Association of Tasmania, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
