THE PRESIDENT: Further to proceedings on 9 December when this matter was listed for registration of the Risdon Prison Redevelopment Project Enterprise Award there were a couple of matters that needed to be clarified by the parties before the award could be approved. Those matters have now been resolved and the parties have provided an amended document and have asked for the award to be made. They seek the making in their absence being satisfied that the award now contains all of the agreed matters and those matters that required clarification.

Accordingly the award will be made to be known as the Risdon Prison Redevelopment Project Enterprise Award. The parties to the award are the Master Builders Association of Tasmania, The Air Conditioning Contractors Employees Industrial Relations Group; the Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the Tasmanian Trades and Labor Council; the unions that have an interest are the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch; the Automotive, Food, Metals, Engineering, Printing and Kindred Industries Union, Tasmanian Branch; the Communication, Electrical, Electronic, Energy, Information, Postal, Plumbing and Allied Services Union of Australia.
