1. TITLE

This Award shall be known as the "Nursing Homes Award".

2. SCOPE

This award is established in respect of the industry of Nursing Homes licensed as such under the Hospitals Act 1918.

PROVIDED that until the making of this award has been finalised in respect to wage rates and conditions of employment or until this proviso has been deleted, employers falling within the Scope of this award, shall, where appropriate classifications appear therein, observe the Hospitals Award in all respects.

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon -

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (b) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award and who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Health Services Union of Australia, Tasmania No. 1 Branch and the Officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope.
- (d) the following organisations of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries.
