AMEND THE **ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS AWARD** IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

**Delete Clause 16 - Holidays with Pay, subclause (a) and insert in lieu thereof the following:**

- (a) All employees (other than casuals, or part-time employees mentioned in subclause (b), Clause 54 - Part-time Employees of Division C) shall be allowed the following days as paid holidays:

New Year's Day, Australia Day, Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in Clause 7), Recreation Day (where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed), Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

**OPERATIVE DATE:**

The operative date for the foregoing amendment is 3 October 1991.

**Delete Clause 47 - Superannuation, subclause (b) (i) and insert in lieu thereof the following:**

- (b) Contributions

- (i) An employer shall make a contribution equivalent to 3% of ordinary time earnings (as defined) into the fund in respect of all eligible employees (as defined). Such earnings shall exclude overtime and allowances in the nature of reimbursement (such as meal money).

Contributions to the fund shall be made by the employer on at least a calendar monthly basis unless there are circumstances for which the employer cannot be held responsible.

**OPERATIVE DATE:**

The operative date for the foregoing amendment is the first full pay period commencing on or after 1 October 1991.
