Labour on-costs – occupational superannuation – payments to approved funds on calendar monthly basis

ORDER No. 1 of 1991

AMEND THE **BARRISTERS AND SOLICITORS AWARD** IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

Delete subclause (a) Contributions, from Clause 18. Occupational Superannuation, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

“(a) Contributions

An employer shall make a contribution equivalent to 3% of ordinary time earnings in respect of all eligible employees as from 1 December 1989. Such earnings shall exclude overtime and allowances in the nature of a reimbursement (such as meal money).

Contributions to the fund shall be made by the employer on at least a calendar monthly basis unless there are circumstances for which the employer cannot be held responsible.”

DATE OF OPERATION

The abovementioned variation shall come into effect from the first full pay period commencing on or after 1 October 1991.
