That agreement derives its salaries and classifications from the Operational Employees Award, which is to be rescinded consistent with the application for the new Tasmania State Service Award.

The employee has been written to and advised that he will be translated to the new Tasmania State Service Award. His classification and salary and terms and conditions and related matters increases significantly. He has raised no objection. The parties to the award have been written to and advised of this. We have received no correspondence. We – the Minister believes that this is consistent with the course of action taken by the Full Bench of the Commission in T13227 in renaming – varying the General Condition of Employment Award and renaming it the Tasmania State Service Award and this matter is consistent with the tidying up of provisions so that superseded awards and agreements are no longer relevant.
