THE **MISCELLANEOUS WORKERS AWARD** IS VARIED AS FOLLOWS:

Delete subclause (a) of Clause 15 - Holidays with Pay and insert the following:

- (a) All employees (other than casuals) shall be allowed the following days as paid holidays:

New Year's Day, Australia Day, Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in Clause 7 - Definitions), Recreation Day (where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed), Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

PROVIDED that employees classified in accordance with this award shall observe the same Public Holidays as are observed by the majority of employees in the establishment in which they are employed.

PROVIDED FURTHER that where a Public Holiday falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Rostered Day Off and is observed on a Saturday, Sunday or Rostered Day Off, the next week day not being a paid holiday shall be observed in lieu.

OPERATIVE DATE

This order shall come into effect from 3 October 1991.
