ORDER BY CONSENT

No. 1 of 1985

Amend Part 1 - Wage Rates; Clause 5 - Margins, Section 11 - Auxilliary Services (Regular Shift Workers) by deleting the final proviso and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"Further provided that employees-classified in item 7 hereof, who are nominated by the company and required to hold a current standard First Aid certificate from St. Johns Ambulance or similar body shall be paid an allowance of \$4.20 per week."

Amend Part 1 - Wage Rates; Clause 7 - Risdon Tradesmen's Special Allowance by deleting the clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following: -

"7. RISDON TRADESMEN'S SPECIAL ALLOWANCE

In addition to the wage rates and allowances prescribed in Clauses 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 hereof, employees classified as tradesmen hereunder shall be paid an allowance of \$5.30 per week pro-rata to hours worked.

The allowance is in recognition of the special skill and diversity required to be exercised by Risdon Tradesmen in the performance of their work."

The foregoing variations shall have effect from the first pay period commencing on or after 1 October 1984.
