ORDER -

AMEND THE **HOSPITALS AWARD** IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

Delete Clause 25 - Holidays, subclause (a), Division A, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) All employees, other than shift workers, casual employees and part-time employees engaged to work less than 20 hours per week shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction from their weekly wages:

Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Cup Day (half day), Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Eight Hours Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in Clause 7) and Recreation Day in those districts where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed, or such other day as may be observed in the locality in lieu of any of the aforementioned holidays.

PROVIDED that the half-day Cup Day shall mean one half of any ordinary rostered shift on that day."

Delete Clause 63 - Holidays, subclause (a), Division B and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) All employees other than shift workers, casual employees and part-time employees engaged to work less than 20 hours per week shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction from their weekly wages - Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Cup Day (half day) Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Eight Hours' Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in Clause 7) Recreation Day in those districts where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed, or such other day as may be observed in the locality in lieu of any of the aforementioned holidays.

PROVIDED that the half-day Cup Day shall mean one half of any ordinary rostered shift on that day."

Delete Clause 96 - Holidays with Pay, subclause (a) Division C and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) All employees shall be allowed the following days as paid holidays: New Year's Day, Australia Day, Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in Clause 7), Recreation Day (where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed), Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

PROVIDED that the half-day Cup Day shall mean one half of any ordinary rostered shift on that day."

Delete Clause 139 - Holidays with Pay, subclause (a) Division D and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(a) All employees, other than shift workers, casual employees and part-time employees engaged to work less than 20 hours per week shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction from their weekly wages - Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Cup Day (half day), Hobart Regatta Day (south of Oatlands), Eight-Hour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, Queen's Birthday, Show Day (as defined in 7) Recreation Day in those districts where Hobart Regatta Day is not observed, or such other day as may be observed in the locality in lieu of any of the abovementioned holidays."
