ORDER BY CONSENT

No. 2 of 2000

THE **BARRISTERS AND SOLICITORS AWARD** IS VARIED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

By deleting from PART III - WAGES AND RELATED MATTERS, Clause 2 - WAGE RATES, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"2. WAGE RATES

Full-time employees classified under this award shall be paid in line with the rates specified in this clause. Part-time employees shall be paid on a pro rata on hours worked.

1. CLERKS

The minimum weekly wage rates that may be paid to adult employees shall be the undermentioned amounts:

The minimum weekly wage rates that may be paid by employers to Accountants shall be:

An Accountant who holds qualifications acceptable for entrance as a Member to the Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia or the Australian Society of Accountants or kindred body having reciprocal arrangements with these Societies in addition to the appropriate wage rate hereinbefore prescribed shall be paid an additional amount of \$13.70 per week.

4. JUNIORS

The minimum weekly wage rate that may be paid by employers to junior employees shall be:
