Delete Clause 6 - Parties and Persons Bound and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

This award shall apply to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award.
- (b) the following organisation of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - the Federated Miscellaneous Workers Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch and the Officers of that organisation and their members for whom classifications appear in this award;
- (c) the Controlling Authority having an interest in this award is the Minister responsible for the administration of the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984, in relation to all employees (as defined)."

DATE OF OPERATION:

The foregoing determination in respect of paragraph (b) shall come into operation from 10 April 1989.
