**Award variation – Part III - Salaries and Related Matters clause 3 Classification Definitions Education Support Specialist - consent application - operative date from 1 February 2021.**

### **DECISION**

**[1]** On 22 December 2021, the Minister administering *the State Service Act 2000* (MASSA) lodged with the Registrar, pursuant to section 23(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1984*, an application to vary the Teaching Service (Tasmanian Public Sector) Award.

**[2]** At the hearing on 3 February 2021, Ms Pook appeared on behalf of Department of Education/MASSA. Mr Steven Smith provided written consent to the variation on behalf of the Australian Education Union, Tasmanian Branch (AEU). The parties provided written submissions.

**[3]** This variation replaces the current definition for the Education Support Specialist classification with a new definition to broaden the required qualifications for this position beyond those who hold a Diploma Educational Support. This qualification is only available in Tasmania. The variation enables people with all relevant qualifications to apply, including those with higher qualifications, which supports a larger pool of potential applicants.

**[4]** All parties submitted the variation sought does not offend the public interest, does not disadvantage those employees covered by the Award and recommended the variation to the Commission

**[5]** I am satisfied that the variation is in the public interest and that no employees are disadvantaged.

**[6]** The application is granted and pursuant to ss 24 and 36 of the Act the Award is varied in accordance with the application. The variations effected are operative from 1 February 2021.
