CORRECTION ORDER

WHEREAS an error occurred in the order giving effect to the Commission's decision of 2 March 1989 (T.1524/T.1525 of 1988) to vary the **MISCELLANEOUS WORKERS (PUBLIC SECTOR) AWARD** in relation to the implementation of the \$10.00 Wage Rate Adjustment, pursuant to Section 21(1) of the Act the Commission hereby corrects Order No 1 of 1989 in the following manner:

Delete Clause 8 - Wage Rates and insert in lieu thereof the following -

"8. WAGE RATES

The minimum weekly rate of pay for employees of a classification hereunder mentioned shall be the amount assigned to that classification.

Leading Hands

In addition to the rates of pay prescribed above leading hands shall be paid the following additional amounts:

- (i) where the leading hand is in charge of not more than five employees \$10.50 extra per week;
- (ii) where the leading hand is in charge of six to ten employees \$13.50 extra per week;
- (iii) where the leading hand is in charge of more than ten employees \$17.90 extra per week."
