AMEND THE **MISCELLANEOUS WORKERS (PUBLIC SECTOR) AWARD** AS FOLLOWS:

**Delete Clause 8 - Wage Rates and insert in lieu thereof the following:-**

**"8. WAGE RATES**

The minimum weekly rate of pay for employees of a classification hereunder mentioned shall be the amount assigned to that classification.

(a) Assistant Matron	303.00
(b) Caretaker - (Resident)	298.70
(c) Caretaker - (Non-Resident)	306.90
(d) Cleaner	297.60
(e) Cook Other (including meals on duty)	289.70
(f) Domestic	278.40
(g) Groundskeeper	297.60
(h) Kitchen Assistant	276.20
(i) Kitchen Assistant - (School)	297.60
(j) Matron	320.40
(k) Matron (with General Nursing Certificate)	327.40
(l) School Farm Hand	297.60
(m) Storeman/Cleaner	302.40
(n) Utility Officer	301.50

**Leading Hands**

In addition to the rates of pay prescribed above leading hands shall be paid the following additional amounts:

- (i) where the leading hand is in charge of not more than five employees \$10.50 extra per week;
- (ii) where the leading hand is in charge of six to ten employees \$13.50 extra per week;
- (iii) where the leading hand is in charge of more than ten employees \$17.90 extra per week."

**DATE OF OPERATION**

The foregoing amendments shall take effect from the beginning of the first full period to commence on or after 15 March 1989.
