Delete Clause 8 - WAGE RATES and insert in lieu thereof the following:

***8. WAGE RATES**

Employees of a classification hereunder mentioned shall be paid the amount assigned opposite that classification as follows:

Supplementary Payment

The amounts appearing in the column headed Supplementary Payment (A) and (B) contained in this clause are absorbable against any overaward payment being paid by an employer as from the beginning of the first full pay period commencing on or after 13 August 1993 in respect of Column (A) and in respect of Column (B), which results from the Arbitrated Safety Net Adjustment Principle as determined in the State Wage Case Decision of 24 December 1993, from the beginning of the first full pay period commencing on or after 17 January 1994.

Leading Hands

Where an employee is appointed a leading hand he/she shall be paid the following rates extra per week:
