Clause 44 - Travelling Time and Allowances

REASONS FOR DECISION

This was an application made by the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries (the Confederation) for amendments to be made to Clause 44 - Travelling Time and Allowances of the Totalizator Agency Board Award.

The Confederation advised that movements in the amounts specified in the clause in question had been aligned from the start to similar prescriptions in the State Service General Conditions of Service Award: this application was aimed at restoring that alignment and it was not considered necessary to substantiate the relevant amounts any more than that on the basis that the Commission had already investigated them on the merits and decided them.

The Confederation submitted that the changes sought were consistent with the Guidelines of the Commission in that the increases sought were on the basis of cost recovery only.

The operative date sought by the Confederation was the 23rd November, 1992.

The Federated Clerks Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch, supported the application.

I accept the submissions of the Confederation, the application is granted, operative from the 23rd November, 1992.
