Award variation— travel and meal allowances – camping allowance – motor vehicle use - consent application - consent order issued— operative date from the first full pay period on or after 17 April 2019

DECISION

[1] On 10 April 2019, the Minister administering the *State Service Act 2000* (MASSA) lodged with the Registrar, pursuant to section 23 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1984* (the Act), an application to vary the Facility Attendants (Tasmanian State Service) Award, TasTAFE Teaching Staff Award and the Teaching Service (Tasmanian Public Sector) Award.

[2] At the hearing in Hobart on 17 April 2019, Ms L Ross and Ms E McCarthy appeared for the MASSA. Ms Celeste Miller appeared for United Voice (UV), and Ms Natalie Marzella appeared for the Australian Education Union, Tasmanian Branch (AEU).

[3] The variations sought increase the amount payable for expense related allowances for travel and meal allowances, camping allowance and motor vehicle use.

[4] Ms Ross provided submissions and stated the variations sought do not offend the public interest, do not disadvantage those employees covered by the Awards and recommended the variations to the Commission with the operative date for the variations to the Awards to be effective from the first full pay period on or after 17 April 2019. Consent to the variation to the Facility Attendants (Tasmanian State Service) Award, TasTAFE Teaching Staff Award and the Teaching Service (Tasmanian Public Sector) Award were provided in oral submissions by Ms Miller and Ms Marzella.

[5] I am satisfied that the application is consistent with the public interest requirements of the Act and does not disadvantage the Award covered employees.

[6] The application for variation is granted with an operative date from the first full pay period on or after 17 April 2019.
