1. Delete subclause (a)(i) from Clause 16 - Mainland Allowances and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"16. MAINLAND ALLOWANCE

(a) Where an employee recruited in this State is transferred from this State in the course of his duties to a headquarters situated on the mainland of Australia and is permanently stationed thereat, the following allowances shall apply:

(i) Accommodation Allowance
(Based on Median Purchase Price - REIA Index)

2. Delete subclause (c) from Clause 16 - Mainland Allowances and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(c) Review of Accommodation Allowance

The allowance specified in paragraph (i) of subclause (a) hereof shall be the subject of annual review having regard to the 'Annual Review of Major Residential Property Markets in Australia' (Median Rental Costs) published by the Real Estate Institute of Australia."
