ORDER -

AMEND THE SECURITY AND WATCHING SERVICES AWARD IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

THE SECURITY AND WATCHING SERVICES AWARD IS AMENDED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

Delete existing Clause 8 - Wage Rates and insert in lieu thereof the following:

**"8. WAGE RATES**

Employees of a classification hereunder mentioned shall be paid the amount assigned opposite that classification.

	Per Week \$
1. Control room operator	311.60
2. Watchman/guard/gatekeeper/escort (as defined)	299.30
3. Mobile patrolman	308.80

**Leading Hands**

Where an employee is appointed a leading hand he/she shall be paid the following rates extra per week:

If in charge of not less than 3 and not more than employees	14.20
If in charge of more than 10 employees	21.10"

**DATE OF OPERATION**

The foregoing amendment shall come into operation from the beginning of the first full pay period to commence on or after 15 September 1988.

**PROVIDED THAT** it is a term of this award arising from the decision of the Tasmanian Industrial Commission State Wage Case of 5 September 1988 the terms of which are set out therein that the unions undertake, until 1 July 1989, not to pursue any extra claims, award or overaward, except where consistent with the State Wage Case Principles.
