Award variation - minimum rates adjustment - fourth increase

REASONS FOR DECISION

This was an application made by the Australian, Municipal, Administrative and Services Union (the Union) for a fourth Minimum Rates Adjustment (MRA) to be implemented in the Textile Award (the Award).

The Union advised the Commission that the MRA process had been introduced into the Award in matter T.3769 of 1992 and this application was merely following in the steps begun then. A draft order was submitted and the Union requested that the increases involved commence from the first full pay period commencing on or after 18 September 1994.

The Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry Limited confirmed its consent to the application and the operative date sought.

The Award will be amended as requested, operative from the first full pay period commencing on or after 18 September 1994.
