CORRECTION ORDER

WHEREAS an error occurred in the order giving effect to the Commission's decision of 21 December 2012 (T13994 of 2012) varying the **MISCELLANEOUS WORKERS (PUBLIC SECTOR) AWARD**, in accordance with Section 19(2)(a) of the Act the Commission hereby corrects Order No. 3 of 2012:

By deleting from Clause 10 – Recreation Leave subclause (b) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“(b) Payment for the Period of Recreation Leave

The rate of salary for an employee during a period of recreation is the normal rate of salary the employee would have received for the ordinary hours of work during the relevant period.

An employee before going on leave is to be paid the amount of salary that the employee would have received for the ordinary hours of work during the relevant period unless the employee opts otherwise.”

OPERATIVE DATE

This correction order shall come into operation from 18 December 2012.
