THE **MISCELLANEOUS WORKERS (PUBLIC SECTOR) AWARD** IS VARIED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

By deleting Clause 6 – PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

This award shall apply to, and be binding upon:-

- (a) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award.
- (b) the following organisation of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Union - Tasmanian Branch of that organisation and their members for whom classifications appear in this award;
- (c) the Controlling Authority having an interest in this award is the Minister responsible for the administration of the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984*, in relation to all employees (as defined).”

This variation shall come into operation from the first full pay period to commence on or after 1 August 2004.
