TIMBER MERCHANTS AWARD

ORDER BY CONSENT

No. 1 of 2002

THE **TIMBER MERCHANTS AWARD** IS VARIED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

By deleting Clause 6 - AWARD INTEREST and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

“6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (b) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award and who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) The Australian Workers' Union, Tasmania Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iii) the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iv) the National Union of Workers, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (v) the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees Association, Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (vi) the Transport Workers' Union of Australia (Victorian/Tasmanian Branch).
- (d) the following organisations of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) the Tasmanian Sawmillers Industrial Association and the officers of that organisation and their members who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;

- (ii) the TFGA Industrial Association and the officers of that organisation and their members who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (iii) the Tasmanian Chamber of Commerce and Industry Limited; and
- (iv) the Tasmanian Chamber of Retailers and the officers of that organisation and their members who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope.”
