The **SEA FISHERIES AWARD** is amended in the following manner:

By deleting Clause 9 - Allowances, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**"9. ALLOWANCES**

(a) Sea Victualling Allowance

An employee is to be paid a sea victualling allowance when required to proceed to sea and to be absent from home overnight:

(b) Sea Going Allowance

An employee who is required to proceed to sea, be absent from port overnight and sleep aboard the vessel is to be paid a sea-going allowance in accordance with the following rates:
