## REASONS FOR DECISION

These two applications were joined and heard together.

Both concerned a request by the Construction Forestry and Mining Employees Union (CFMEU) that its name be substituted for that of the Building Workers' Industrial Union (BWIU) in the "Parties and Persons Bound" clauses of the Shipbuilders and Marine Boards Awards.

Mr Clifford of the CFMEU took the Commission through a series of steps showing where the BWIU had changed its name to the CFMEU and how the appropriate changes had been acknowledged by the Registrar of the Commission and by a Full Bench of the Commission in its decision  $^1\cdot$  of 15 May 1992.

As a consequence the matter before me represents a final step in a series of processes which have preceded it. The only other organisation to appear in this matter, the Australian Workers Union (AWU) raised no objection to the award change as proposed at this time, but put on record its reservations if further amalgamations are contemplated by the applicant in this matter.

Since the name change is consequential the application to substitute the CFMEU for the BWIU in both awards is approved and the amendments will be affected.
