First minimum rates adjustment and occupational superannuation provisions

REASONS FOR DECISION

In this matter The Amalgamated Footwear & Textile Workers' Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch sought the variation of the Textile Award to include the first minimum rates adjustment and occupational superannuation provisions.

Minimum Rates Adjustment

The minimum rates adjustment is based on establishing appropriate relativities in the award having regard to the Tradesperson's rate which is currently \$417.20.

The variation is in accord with the Minimum Rates Adjustment Wage Fixing Principle as first established in the State Wage Case of October 1989.

The award will be varied operative from the first pay period to commence on or after 10 February 1992.

Occupational Superannuation

The proposed clause complies with the Superannuation Wage Fixing Principle and accordingly is endorsed operative from the first full pay period to commence on or after 1 January 1992.
