COMMISSIONER WATLING: Let the record show that since the adjournment we've had approximately one day discussing the matters off the record. The parties have discussed a number of issues, especially relating to classification standards and award structures.

We are now going to adjourn to a date to be fixed. During the intervening period, the union and the employer will have discussions. When the hearing reconvenes I will hear submissions from the applicant in relation to the datum point for the work value case, or this component of this case, which is work value, and then we will adjourn into private conference, once again, where we'll finalise any outstanding issues. So we will go on the record when we reconvene to look at that question only, the datum point for the work value case.

Now I'll await a telephone call from the parties, or one or both of you, if you desire, before I reconvene the hearing on the next occasion. And when I say reconvene the hearing, I'm talking about the conferences well after the hearing.
