BASIS OF CALCULATION FOR RATES OF PAY FOR SALARIES AND RECREATION LEAVE LOADING, WHICH WILL APPLY FROM THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE FIRST FULL PAY PERIOD TO BEGIN ON OR AFTER 1 MARCH 2010, AS PROVIDED FOR IN CLAUSE 7. SALARIES.
