## 1. Insert in Clause 18, subclause (c) Contributions, paragraph (i) the following:

**"PROVIDED** that for employees covered by Division B of this award contributions shall be at the rate of 3% of an agreed retainer or 3% of the minimum wage whichever is the greater."

# 2. Insert in Clause 18, subclause (e) Exemptions, paragraph (v) the following:

(v) "Applications for exemptions in respect of employees covered by Division B of this award may be made on the same basis as outlined above.

**PROVIDED** that employers shall have until 31 January 1990 to make application for exemption in respect of Division B employees."

### 3. Insert in Clause 18, subclause (f) Operative Date the following:

"**PROVIDED** that for employees covered by Division B of this award the operative date shall be the beginning of the first pay period on or after 1 February 1990."

#### 4. Insert in Clause 27, General Conditions the following:

"18. Occupational Superannuation"

#### **DATE OF OPERATION**

The foregoing amendments shall take effect from the beginning of the first full pay period to commence on or after 17 February 1990.
