THE ABOVE AWARD IS VARIED AS FOLLOWS:

Delete subclause (c) of Clause 6 - Parties and Persons Bound and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:

- (i) the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (ii) the Federated Clerks Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2- Scope;
- (iii) the Metals and Engineering Workers' Union and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;"
