**ORDER BY CONSENT**

**AMEND THE SURVEYORS (PRIVATE INDUSTRY) AWARD AS FOLLOWS:**

AMEND THE SURVEYORS (PRIVATE INDUSTRY) AWARD IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:-

Delete existing Clause 25 and insert in lieu thereof the following:-

**25. SUPERANNUATION**

- (a) As from the first pay period to commence on or after 1 January 1989 employers shall, in respect of all eligible employees contribute an amount of 3% of each employees' ordinary pay each week into an approved superannuation fund.
- (b) For the purpose of this Clause:-

**'Approved Fund'** means TASPLAN or a fund which complies with the Insurance and Superannuation Commission requirements and is approved in writing by A.D.S.T.E.

**'Ordinary Weekly Salary'** means the normal weekly salary as expressed in Clause 8 of this Award.

**'Eligible Employee'** means an employee with a minimum of two weeks service in the case of weekly and part-time employees.

In the case of casual employees, a superannuation payment equivalent to 3% of ordinary time earnings shall be made on each occasion a casual employee works at least 76 hours in each calendar month.

DATE OF OPERATION:

The foregoing variation will take effect from the first pay period commencing on or after 1 January 1989.
