**REASONS FOR DECISION**

In this matter the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union - Tasmanian Branch sought the variation of the Security Industry Award to give effect to the fourth minimum rates adjustment. The proposed adjustment is in accordance with the agreed position of the parties as outlined in matter T.3129 of 1991. Also the impact of the 2.5% State Wage Case<sup>1</sup> decision has been taken into account.

Accordingly the adjustment is endorsed operative from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after 13 February 1993.
