DECISION

- [1] On 10 August 2105, applications were lodged by the Minister administering the State Service Act 2000 pursuant to s.23 of the Industrial Relations Act 1984, to vary the TasTAFE Teaching Staff Award and the Teaching Service (Tasmanian Public Sector) Award. On the same date, applications were lodged by the Minister administering the State Service Act 2000 (MASSA) and the Australian Education Union, Tasmanian Branch, (AEU), pursuant to Section 59(1) of the Industrial Relations Act 1984, to vary the Teaching Service Salaries and Conditions of Employment Agreement 2014 and the TasTAFE Teaching Staff Industrial Agreement 2014.
- [2] At the request of the parties these applications were joined.

- [3] At the hearing in Hobart on 1 September 2015, Ms Sharyn Haas appeared for MASSA and Ms Kirsten Siejka for the AEU.
- [4] Ms Haas explained that the purpose of the applications was to correct numerical errors which had been detected in the relevant salary scales in previously approved industrial instruments.
- [5] Details of the corrections are contained in the file.
- [6] Ms Siejka advised that the AEU consented to the applications.
- [7] I am satisfied that all applications are consistent with the public interest requirements of the Act.
- **[8]** In relation to T14328 of 2015 and T14329 of 2015, I am satisfied that employees will not be disadvantaged as a consequence of the variation being approved.
- [9] Applications T14325 and T14327 are granted and the Awards will be varied accordingly.
- **[10]** Applications T14328 and T14329 are approved pursuant to s.59 of the Act and the respective agreements varied accordingly.
- **[11]** In each case the operative date is from 1 September 2015 noting that each application has retrospective application
- [12] +The orders reflecting this decision will follow.
