Conditions of employment - allowances - expense and wage related allowances

**Order - No. 2 of 1992**

The above award is varied as follows:

1. In Clause 8 - Wage Rates, Division A - General Cartage, delete subclause 2. - Items Previously Considered for Adjustment on Economic Grounds and insert in lieu thereof the following:

**2. ITEMS PREVIOUSLY CONSIDERED FOR ADJUSTMENT  
ON ECONOMIC GROUNDS**

**PROVIDED THAT** this item shall not apply to leading loader.

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- (b) Any employee required to drive a motor vehicle in excess of 16.8 metres in length shall receive an additional \$1.76 per day or part thereof.
- (c) Any employee required to drive a motor vehicle with a truck loading crane mounted on the vehicle shall receive an additional \$1.76 per day.
- (d) Any employee required to drive a motor vehicle in excess of 3.5 metres in width or transport a load in excess of that width shall receive an additional \$1.76 per day or part thereof.
- (e) Employee who is a recognised furniture carter engaged in removing and/or delivering furniture (as defined) 9.90
- (f) Employee who is a recognised livestock carter carting livestock as defined 9.90
- (g) Employee driving sanitary vehicle 11.10
- (h) Employee driving vehicle collecting garbage 9.00
- (i) Driver required to act as salesman of goods in his vehicle 1.80
- (j) Driver-salesman (as defined) 8.20

Note: no employee shall be entitled to receive in any one week both the additional amounts set out in items (g) and (h) of this subclause.

- (k) Employee carting, loading and/or unloading carbon black except when packed in sealed metal containers, an extra \$1.10 per day or part thereof.
- (l) Employee carting, loading and/or unloading offensive material 1.25

**PROVIDED THAT** a higher amount for any load or quantity that is particularly offensive may be fixed.

- (m) Employee carting, loading and/or unloading dirty material, an extra 22 cents per hour.

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- (n) Employee who is required to cart tar (other than in sealed containers) for immediate spreading upon streets, tar in unsealed containers, or tarred material for spreading upon streets; and/or who spreads either of them upon streets, an extra 1.70
- (o) Coffin allowance - employees required to handle coffins containing human remains shall be paid an amount of \$1.50 for each coffin handled.
- (p) Employee handling money (as defined)  
For any amount handled:
  - up to \$20 0.80
  - over \$20 but not exceeding \$200 1.70
  - over \$200 but not exceeding \$600 3.00
  - over \$600 but not exceeding \$1000 3.80
  - over \$1000 but not exceeding \$1200 5.30
  - over \$1200 but not exceeding \$1600 8.20
  - over \$1600 but not exceeding \$2000 9.30
  - over \$2000 10.50

Note: Where a higher further additional amount becomes payable under any item of this subclause number (d), (e), (f), (i), (j), (k) or (1), it shall supersede any lesser additional amount contained in these items which otherwise would have been liable for payment.

- 2. Delete the amount "\$5.00" appearing in Clause 19 - First Aid Allowance and insert in lieu thereof "\$5.90".
- 3. Delete the amount "\$5.50" twice appearing in subclause (c) of Clause 29 - Meal Times and insert in lieu thereof "\$7.35".
- 4. In Clause 32 - Payment of Wages: Delete the amounts "\$6.95" and "\$9.20" appearing in subclauses (d) and (f) respectively and insert in lieu thereof "\$8.10" and "\$10.40" respectively.
- 5. Delete the amount "\$16.05" appearing in Clause 41 - Travelling Allowance and insert in lieu thereof "\$20.50".
