**SECURITY INDUSTRY AWARD**

**ORDER - No. 3 of 1992**

The above award is varied as follows:

1. Delete subclause (c)(ii) of Clause 6 Parties and Persons Bound and insert the following:

"(ii) The Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, Tasmanian Branch and officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the Industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope."

2. Delete Clause 24 Preference of Employment and insert the following:

**"24. PREFERENCE OF EMPLOYMENT**

Unless otherwise agreed, employees shall be financial members of the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, Tasmanian Branch and an accredited official of the union shall be allowed to interview employees on legitimate union business during meal breaks."

3. Delete sub-clause (a)'Union' of Clause 33, Superannuation and insert the following:

"`Union' means the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union, Tasmanian Branch."

**Date of Operation**

The foregoing variation shall have effect from 3 August 1992.
