Award variation - union structure - change of name

ORDER - No. 2 of 1992

AMEND THE **SHIPPING AWARD** IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

1. By deleting Clause 6 - Parties and Persons Bound, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (b) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award and who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) The Australian Institute of Marine and Power Engineers and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union - Tasmanian Branch, and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iii) the Federated Clerks Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iv) the Merchant Service Guild of Australia, Victorian and Tasmanian Branches and the officers of that organisation and their members who are employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (d) the following organisation of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:

the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries."

2. By deleting Clause 16 - Implementation of 38-Hour Week, subclause (1) - On Site Agreements, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"(1) On Site Agreements

Any agreement reached pursuant to subclause (c) of this clause shall be notified in writing to the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union - Tasmanian Branch, and to the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries within 14 days of its making.

At any time either party to such agreement may seek to review the agreement provided that should the agreement be altered, details of the alteration shall be notified in writing to the Australian Liquor, Hospitality and Miscellaneous Workers Union - Tasmanian Branch, and to the Tasmanian Confederation of Industries."

OPERATIVE DATE:

The foregoing variations shall have effect from 3 August 1992.
