REASONS FOR DECISION

This was an application by the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch (the Union) for an amendment to be made to the Timber Merchants Award (the Award).

The application followed the amalgamation of The Federated Engine Drivers' and Firemen's Association of Australasia with the Construction Forestry and Mining Employees Union in the jurisdiction of the Australian Industrial Relations Commission on 23 September 1992 forming the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union. That amalgamation was recognised in this jurisdiction on 18 December 1992 when the registration of The Federated Engine Drivers' and Firemen's Association of Australasia, Tasmanian Branch was cancelled by a full bench of the Commission.¹

This application seeks merely to change the name of the Construction Forestry and Mining Employees Union, Tasmanian Branch in the parties and persons bound clause of the Award to that of the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch.

This is clearly a consequential, procedural name change following the ratification of the amalgamation in this jurisdiction and the application is therefore granted operative from 18 January 1993.
