Delete Clause 6 - Parties and Persons Bound and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"6. PARTIES AND PERSONS BOUND

Unless otherwise specified, this award shall have application to and be binding upon:

- (a) all employers (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (b) all employees (whether members of a Registered Organisation or not) for whom classifications appear in this award and who are engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (c) the following organisations of employees in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) The Australian Building Construction Employees' and Builders Labourers' Federation, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) The Federated Furnishing Trade Society of Australasia, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iii) The Operative Painters and Decorators' Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (iv) the Construction, Forestry, Mining and Energy Union, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (v) the Transport Workers' Union of Australia, Tasmanian Branch and the officers of that organisation and their members employed in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
- (d) the following organisations of employers in respect of whom award interest has been determined:
 - (i) The Master Builders' Association of Tasmania and the officers of that organisation and their members engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
 - (ii) The Retail Traders Association of Tasmania and the officers of that organisation and their members engaged in the industry specified in Clause 2 - Scope;
