ORDER BY CONSENT :

No. 2 of 1985

AMEND THE VETERINARY SERVICES AWARD, PART II - CONDITIONS, IN THE  
FOLLOWING MANNER:

1. Clause 3 - Meal and Meal Allowance - delete the amount "\$4.50" appearing in sub-clauses (b) and (c) and insert in lieu thereof "\$4.70".
2. Clause 11 - Clothing Allowance - delete the amounts "\$4.90" and "\$3.60" appearing in sub-clause (a) and insert in lieu thereof "\$5.10" and "\$3.70" respectively.

The above variations shall have effect from the first pay period to commence on or after 4 November 1985.

Provided that, it is a term of this award that the unions undertake that they will not pursue any extra claims, award or overaward, except where consistent with the Principles of Wage Fixation of the Tasmanian Industrial Commission.
