AMEND THE WHOLESALE TRADES AWARD IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

AMEND THE WHOLESALE TRADES AWARD IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

1. Delete Division B - COMMERCIAL TRAVELLERS - from Clause 8. WAGE RATES - and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"DIVISION B - COMMERCIAL TRAVELLERS

1. WAGES

The minimum rates of wages that may be paid to employees shall be the undermentioned:

	Amount Per Week

1. Country traveller	378.50
2. Town or local traveller	349.90
3. Probationary traveller	316.40"

2. Delete the following clauses:

Clause 33 - ANNUAL LEAVE
Clause 36 - HOURS
Clause 38 - SICK LEAVE

3. Renumber the remaining clauses in CONDITIONS FOR EMPLOYEES IN DIVISION B accordingly, viz.:

Clause 33 - EXPENSES AND ACCOMMODATION
Clause 34 - GENERAL CONDITIONS
Clause 35 - LOCOMOTION
Clause 36 - SPECIAL ALLOWANCES

4. Delete the renumbered Clause 34 - GENERAL CONDITIONS - and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"34. GENERAL CONDITIONS

The provisions of the following clauses in Division A shall also apply to employees in this division:

- 28. Saving
- 30. Sick Leave
- 32. Superannuation"

5. Amend Clause 3 - ARRANGEMENT - in accordance with the foregoing variations.

The foregoing variations shall take effect from the first pay period commencing on or after 16 August 1989.
