ORDER BY CONSENT -

No. 2 of 1985

AMEND THE **DENTISTS AWARD, PART II - CONDITIONS**, IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

Clause 2 - Overtime - delete the amount "\$4.50" appearing in sub-clause (b) and insert in lieu thereof "\$4.70".

The above variations shall have effect from the first pay period on or after 4 November 1985.

Provided that, it is a term of this award that the unions undertake that they will not pursue any extra claims, award or overaward, except where consistent with the Principles of Wage Fixation of the Tasmanian Industrial Commission.
