ORDER - No. 5 of 1994

The above award is amended as follows:

1. Amend Clause 37 - Overtime, subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section I - Conditions for Clerks and Employees Employed in Retail Shops, Clause 64 - Overtime, subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section II - Conditions for Employees Employed in "Supermarkets" (as defined) and Clause 75 - Overtime - subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section III - Conditions for Employees (other than Clerks) Employed in Smallgoods Establishments by adding the following:

"This paragraph shall not apply in cases where it is customary for an employee to return to his employer's premises to perform a specific job outside his ordinary working hours, or where the overtime is continuous (subject to a reasonable meal break) with the completion or commencement of ordinary working time. Overtime worked in the circumstances specified in this paragraph shall not be regarded as overtime for the purpose of subclause (c) of this clause when the actual time worked is less than three hours on such recall on each of such recalls."

2. Amend Clause 37- Overtime, subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section I - Conditions for Clerks and Employees Employed in Retail Shops, Clause 64 - Overtime, subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section II - Conditions for Employees Employed in `Supermarkets" (as defined) and Clause 75 - Overtime - subclause (d), paragraph (ii), Section III - Conditions for Employees (other than Clerks) Employed in Smallgoods Establishments by inserting as subclauses (g), (h) and (g) respectively the following:

"An employee required to hold himself on stand-by for a recall to work shall be supplied by the employer with a pager or mobile telephone."

3. Amend clause 54 by deleting the amount of 19 cents appearing therein and inserting in lieu thereof the amount of 38 cents.

OPERATIVE DATE

The award will be operative from the first full pay period to commence on or after 24 June 1994.
