**By deleting CLAUSE 2 - OVERTIME, and inserting in lieu thereof the following;**

## **2. OVERTIME**

- (a) For all time worked in excess of the hours prescribed in Clause 1 (Hours) hereof, payment shall be made at the rate of time and a half for the first 2 hours and double time thereafter.
- (b) Where overtime exceeds 60 minutes on any day, employees shall be paid a meal allowance of \$4.50 in addition to the overtime rate prescribed.

**Operative Date:** As from the first pay period to commence on or after 6 April 1985.
