## TRANSCRIPT OF PROCEEDINGS

Unedited

PRESIDENT: There are no changes in appearances are there? So, Mr Baker.

MR BAKER: Well, sir, I suppose the easiest way to progress the matter this afternoon is to simply request that the matter be adjourned into a conference under your chairmanship and we'll bring you up to date exactly where we've gotten to this morning. I think that might be the easiest way around it.

PRESIDENT: All right. Is that agreed by all of the parties? All right. We're off record.

## INTO CONFERENCE

PRESIDENT: Well thank you for that. We've progressed insofar as we've determined a method of proceeding with the application. It's been agreed that Mr Baker's organisation will make application in respect of allowances going to commercial travellers and the general application of 48 cents per kilometre in the award; that the - an application will also be made in respect of clerks and sellers of spare parts insofar as travelling and accommodation allowances are concerned. And a third application will be forthcoming in respect of three classifications: roadhouse attendant, exhaust repair person, I think it is, and brake repair person.

When we resume on the 13th December, a consent document dealing with what's currently before us will be tendered and we'll examine the way in which we'll proceed with the other matters and it may be necessary to go to arbitration on some of them, and others might be set aside for later consideration.

Does that summarise where we got to?

MR BAKER: Yes, sir.
